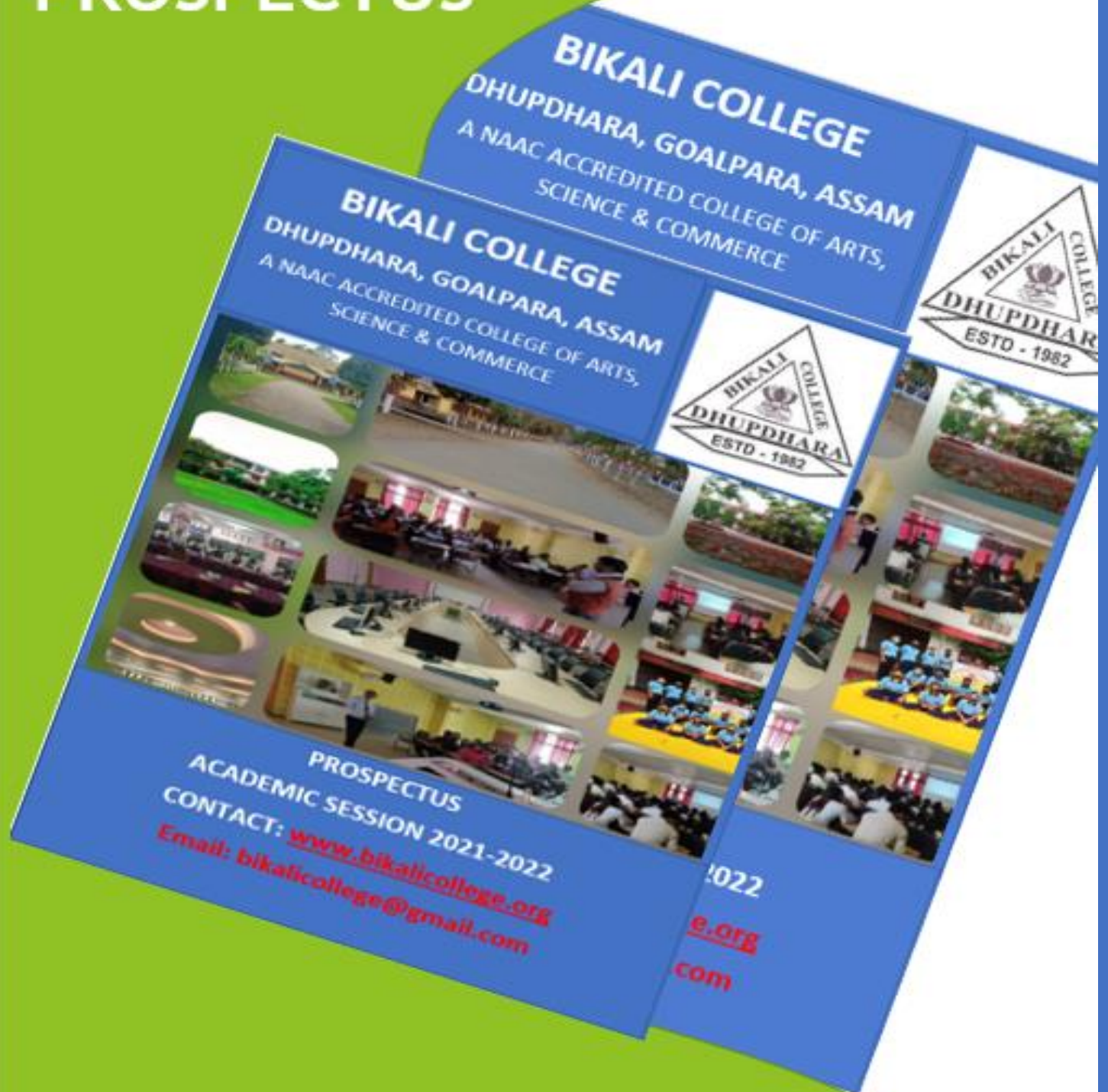

*Bikali College is one of the premier institutions of higher education in the state of Assam. It is located at Dhupdhara, a small town on the National Highway 37 in the easternmost part of Goalpara District of Assam. Bikali college has a chequered history of establishment and existence. It is the result of the culmination of the long-drawn dream and the wish and aspiration of the 52 villages of the "Bikali Mouza". Their relentless efforts and the missionary zeal to enlighten their children with higher education led to the establishment of this institution on 14th April in the year 1982. From a makeshift wooden and bamboo structure with only few students in Pre-University classes in Arts stream, the college has come a long way telling the stories of struggle, achievements, growth and consolidation. In the course of its growth and development, the commerce stream and science stream were introduced in the college as self-financing course in the year 2005 and 2015, respectively. The college is currently affiliated to Gauhati University and is presently offering bachelor degree courses in Arts, Science and Commerce along with post graduate Master degree courses in Assamese and Geography. In addition to these courses, the college also offered certificate courses in Higher Secondary in all the three streams under AHSEC. The Arts stream of the college was brought under Deficit Grants-in-Aid schemes of government of Assam in 1992 and subsequently it was provincialized in the year 2005. The college has also been able to receive UGC recognition of 2(f) 12(B) with effect from the 10th Plan.*

## ELIGIBILITY FOR ADMISSION

1. HIGHER SECONDARY COURSE: For admission into Higher Secondary First Year Science, Arts and Commerce, a candidate must pass H.S.L.C. Examination or any other equivalent Examinations.
2. DEGREE COURSE: For admission into Degree (Arts) course, a candidate must pass Higher Secondary or any other equivalent examinations from secondary school or university. For admission into Degree (Commerce) a candidate must pass H.S. Arts / Commerce / Science / Vocational or equivalent examination.
3. P. G. COURSE: For admission into P. G. Course in Assamese and Geography a candidate must pass Degree course with Assamese and Geography as Major subject.

The selection process for admission in PG courses in Assamese and Geography Department is based on the entrance examination conducted by Gauhati University.

4. For all the courses, selection will be made on merit basis through selection procedure by the College authority.
5. Candidates selected must take admission within the schedule time.
6. The concerned department will take decision in selecting candidates in "Honours course".
7. The decision of the Academic committee regarding any admission shall be final.

## **PROCEDURE FOR APPLICATION**

Application for admission to the first semester classes of Three Years Degree Course (CBCS) and H.S. First Year can be filled online through online admission portal to be activated on scheduled time after official notification and declaration of the H.S. Final examination and H.S.L.C examination results. The last date of submission of forms and dates of interview/admission for admission will be notified in the website and college notice board. Scanned copies of the following documents are to be submitted online during the time of online form filled up.

Mark sheet of particular examination passed.

Three copies of passport size photographs signed by the candidate (duly attested).

N.B: However, the original of the same must be produced for verification whenever necessary.

**Students who wish to avail Hostel accommodation should apply online for the hostel seat in the admission portal.**

## REGISTRATION

A student after taking admission in HS / TDC shall be required to register his/her name with ASSAM HIGHER SECONDARY COUNCIL and GAUHATI UNIVERSITY through the College immediately after the first year of admission.

## EXAMINATION AND EVALUATION

Examination and Evaluation shall be conducted according to the Ordinances / Regulations of the AHSEC and Gauhati University. A student shall be declared successful with 'Honours' if she obtains minimum 30% marks in all compulsory papers, securing minimum 45% marks in the Elective Honours paper in aggregate (all Honours paper taken together from I to VI Semesters). A student shall be declared successful with 'Simple pass' if she obtains minimum 30% marks in all compulsory papers, securing not less than 33% marks, but less than 45% marks in the Honours Paper in aggregate in all Elective Honours Paper taken together from I to VI Semesters.

## ASSESSMENT

During the current academic session, the College will conduct the following tests for all classes for assessment:

**Internal assessment:** There will be internal tests and assignments conducted by the College. Students who fail to fulfil the requirements for the internal semester marks (Internal Tests and Assignments) will not be allowed to appear in the Final Semester Examination.

**Departmental Seminars and Projects:** Seminars are regularly held in the College to expose and enlighten the students about the newly developed fields of research relevant to their studies.

It is compulsory that the students appear in all the above tests. Permission form will be issued from the departments if they are to be selected/ not selected to appear for the final examination.

## HOSTEL



The girls' and boys' hostel are within the college campus. The girls hostel has 80 seats, whereas the boys has only 30 seats. Any students seeking admission into the hostel must apply through online with necessary documents. For safety and security of the hostel, the hostel is under CCTV coverage round the clock. Twenty-four hours electricity with inverter and generator for power back-up, running water with acquaguard clean drinking water facility, free computer learning facility after 4 P.M. etc. are some of the key facilities provided to the hostel boarders.

## LIBRARY



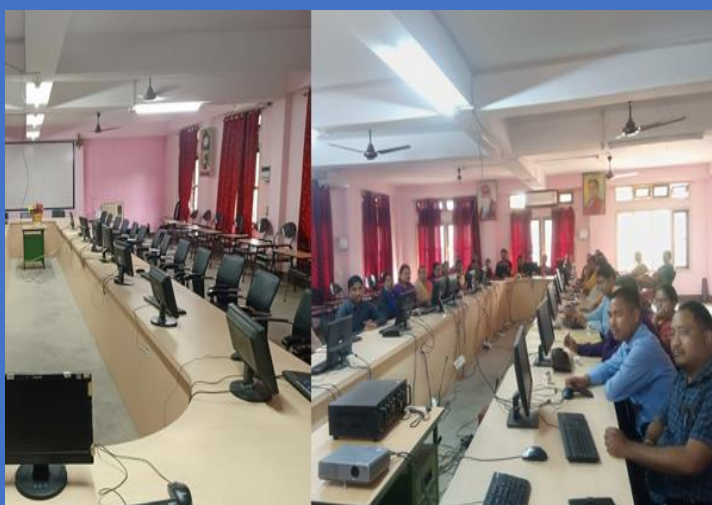

## SMART DIGITAL CLASSROOMS



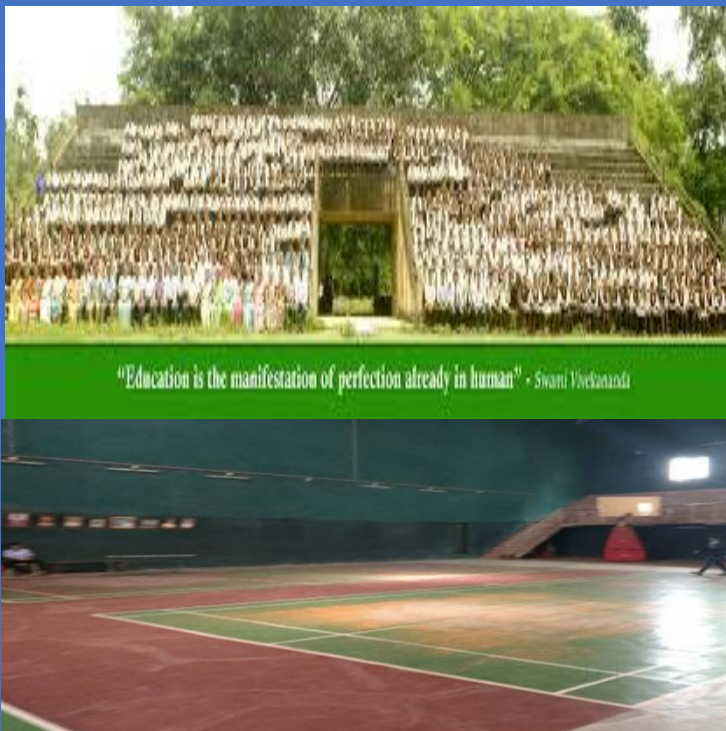

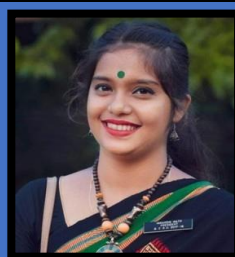

## GENERAL RULES AND INFORMATION

### COLLEGE HOURS: FROM 9 A.M. TO 4.15 P.M.

1. No student shall be admitted in any course of studies if he / she is found to have indulged in activities detrimental to academic interest.
2. A student who is found to violate the College rules shall be liable to expulsion.
3. Those Students admitted to various courses of studies are compulsory to participate in lectures, tutorial classes, remedial classes and other academic activities. Besides, they are required to participate in the co-curricular and extracurricular activities organized by departments and by constituent agencies of the institution.
4. Students must appear at the examinations conducted by the academic bodies, such as class test, unit test, pre-final test and Final Examinations.
5. Students found to have consumed intoxicating drinks, drugs, tobacco and indulged in immoral activities shall be liable to expulsion.
6. Students shall have to obey the Rules and Regulations as may be prescribed by college, AHSEC and by Gauhati University authorities.
7. Any student indulging in ragging or involved in any such act is liable to expulsion from the College.
8. Decision of Governing body and Disciplinary committee in all matters relating to student's indiscipline shall be final and binding required to participate in the co-curricular and extracurricular activities organized by departments and by constituent agencies of the institution.

### DISCIPLINE MAINTENANCE

- (A) Every student should come to the college with his Identity Card and follow proper academic decorum.
- (B) Students having less than 75% of attendance in each subject are not eligible to appear in the University/ Council Examination.
- (C) Students should keep the college premise clean and use the college property with proper care.
